The undersigned further agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the MDVC, Host City, Sponsors, and their officers, agents, volunteers, and employees from any and all claims resulting from property damage or injuries, including death and losses of my / its agents, volunteers, parade participants and employees, sustained by and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with my /its participation in the Parade. The undersigned has read and agrees to abide by the Parade Rules and Regulations. The undersigned understands that failure to comply with all stated rules and regulations may result in the removal of its entry from this and future parades.
